I have had such a wonderful experience, travelling to more than a dozen schools in Helsinki and Kokkola, Finland, speaking to school Principals, students, teachers, university professors and ministry of education personnel, learning more about what makes their system one of the best in the world. While I will be sharing some of my reflections over time, however, I will say that NSW is held in very high regard with their Finnish counterparts. The influence of Pasi Salhusburg, previously Minister of Education in Finland, now employed by DoE, is evident in our system. The designs of many of the new schools across the state allow for integrated learning, use of a variety of learning modes, student centred options, as well as direct classroom and group teaching opportunities. Interesting fact: Outdoor play is highly valued and students have a 15 minute break between every lesson!
