The influence of Pasi Salhsburg, previously Minister of Education in Finland, now employed by DoE, is evident in our system. The designs of many of the new schools across the state allow for integrated learning, use of a variety of learning modes, student centred options, as well as direct classroom and group teaching opportunities. Interesting fact: Outdoor play is highly valued and students have a 15 minute break between every lesson!
