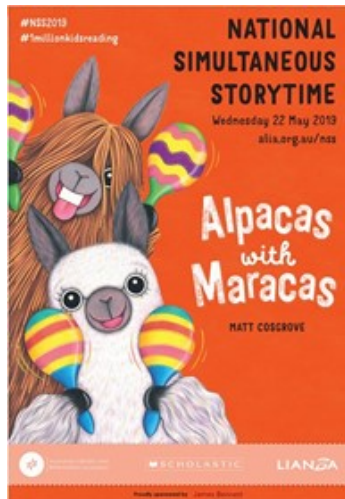

Please include online payment receipt number on the paper bag.

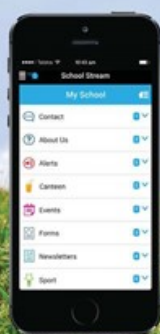
