If you hear of an incident, please report it to the bus company first. They do have a system of warning students and families of poor behaviour, which can lead to suspension from bus travel, but incidents must be reported. This can be done online or by phone.

Cash—correct money is appreciated.

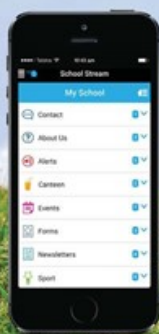

3. Click on **ORDER** and enter the item number from the Book Club catalogue.
4. All orders are placed directly to the school for submission to Scholastic. Books will all be delivered to your child's account if you order by the due date.
