Please include online payment receipt number on the paper bag. Cash—correct money is appreciated.

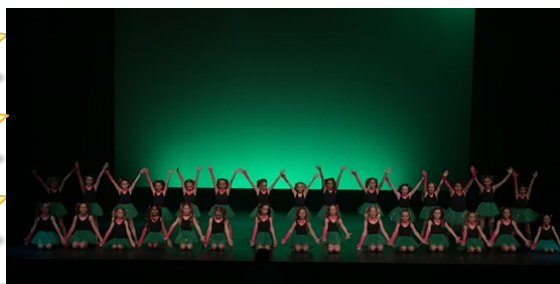

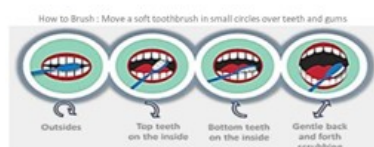
