Kindergarten Enrolments

Game Changer Challenge

Welcome back to our "Game Changer team", a design thinking challenge, sponsored by NSW Department of Education.

Inspired by the need to take learning from the classroom into the real world, the Game Changer Challenge was launched in 2018, to expose students and teachers to the problem-solving methodology known as Design Thinking.



From a video submission, and with over 120 entries from primary schools, Kingscliff Public School was selected as one of nine primary school teams to compete. They spent last week with leading academics, education, technology and design-thinking professionals to solve the problem, *How might we humanise technology?*

The three-day program started with an industry immersion experience at the Australian headquarters of Google in Pyrmont. They attended a Q&A-style panel, moderated by the Secretary of the Department of Education, Mark Scott. Speakers with expertise in future technologies spoke to the critical question across a range of areas such as agriculture, military, sustainability, virtual reality, ethics, humanity, robotics and artificial intelligence.

The next two days at Game Changer HQ, in Parramatta, students designed a solution to the Challenge question: *How might we design technology to better serve humans?* Using world-leading education technologies under the guidance of design-thinking mentors and future-thinking experts. Teachers to connect with each other, industry experts and facilitators to learn and reflect on the applications of Design Thinking in the classroom.

The event concluded with a "Shark Tank" pitch session to a panel of industry and education experts. Our team used technology, drama and collaboration to answer their pitch idea of How might we encourage young people to put plastic waste in the correct bin? They engaged their audience and came up with an app-based idea called 'Binstad'. While we did not win, they worked together and had a fantastic time representing our school. Well done, team!

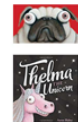
