#### Changes to parking signs in Orient Street and Sutherland Street

New parking signs are being installed next week to improve safety and traffic flow. The new parking signs will be installed on **Tuesday 20 October 2020**. The '5 minute' parking signs in Orient Street and Sutherland Street will be replaced with:




In the interest of student's safety, please do not arrive in **any part** of the school zone before 3pm, if you are using the drop off/pick-up zones. We do not want the surrounding streets congested with traffic waiting to queue.

Drop off/pick-up zones should function like a fast moving taxi rank. If your child is not ready you must leave the zone and continue around the block and re-join the queue.

#### Parking signs and penalties in a school zone

NO STOPPING	No Stopping Under no circumstances are you to stop on a length of road to which a 'No Stopping' sign or yellow 'No Stopping' line applies.	Penalty \$344 + 2 demerit points (school zone)
	No Parking You can stop in this zone while you are dropping off or picking up passengers. You must not stop for more than two minutes in a 'No Parking' area. You must remain in or within 3 metres of the vehicle.	Penalty \$191 + 2 demerit points (school zone)
	Children's Crossing You must not stop on or near a children's crossing.	Penalty \$457 + 2 demerit points (school zone)




