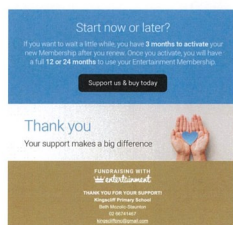
1. Gingerbread House

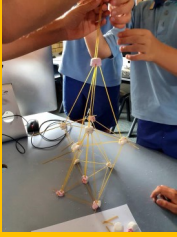
