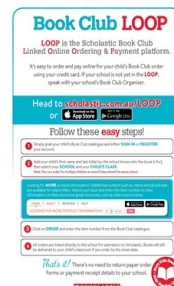
### P&C Association – Join our Team!

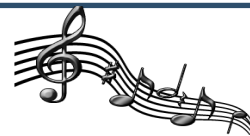
