Student Resources

Each year, we ask that families contribute toward their child's education by paying "voluntary school contributions" (formerly known as school fees). The fee is only \$40 per year. You can pay \$10 per term if this is easier for you. This fee covers the following items:

- ♦ Maths mental books (\$15)- which students are already using
- ♦ Online subscriptions to Mathletics and PM readers (\$10 each) - already in use.
- ♦ Subsidising the cost of all exercise books used in class (\$5). The school pays the balance.

In addition, personal stationery items are to be supplied by each child. Lists went out last year and many orders have arrived from online orders placed last year. If you have not yet filled your child's stationery order, you can purchase the items at many stores. Please refer to School Stream for the lists for each year group. Thank you, in advance, for supporting your child's learning.

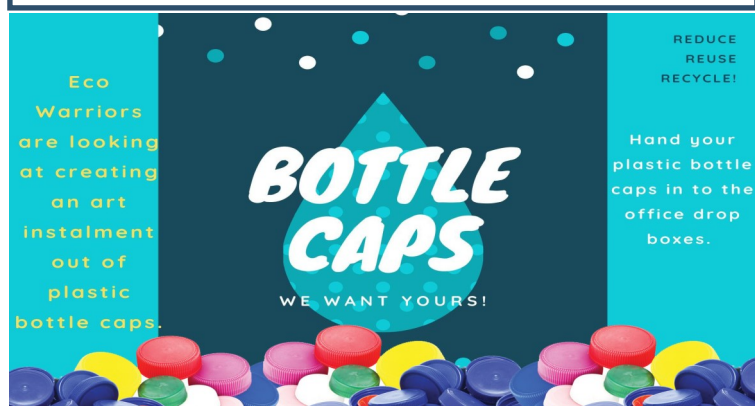
