



Tweed Shire Council will commence on-road trials of the Parking Enforcement Vehicle (PEV) by the end of February 2020 during which time no enforcement action will be taken if the vehicle detects an offence. On that note, I hope that your homes are full of lots of wonderful sounds...they will all improve with practice I guarantee it!


