Safety Message - Pick up zone

Mrs. Mirana and I work very hard to keep our pick up zone moving smoothly each afternoon, but we need your assistance. Please consider the following points:

- Having a name card on your dashboard, or visor, really assists us to call students to the curb. Please make your own, or call the office and they will happily assist. In making your own, they must be printed in large bold, black font. We cannot see handwritten signs in the glare of the sun, nor from a distance.
- Remember, the pickup area is a NO Parking Zone, in the afternoon. Stay in your vehicle. Empty cars block other vehicles and reduce the flow of traffic. Council rangers do patrol and issue fines to cars illegally parked.


