CO-VID 19 Update

Information on how to support students during this health emergency have been posted on our website, along with an FAQ sheet provided by the Department of Education. Please be reassured that, Kingscliff Public School remains committed to the wellbeing of our students and staff and we are following the advice of the Department of Education, which is based on the latest Health Department advice. At this stage schools will remain open unless there is an identified case of the virus. We will respond quickly to any change in this advice as a result of the dynamic nature of this event.

Additional things we are doing include:

- Reminding students to wash hands after using the toilet, before eating, and to use sanitiser in their classrooms.
- Doors and windows are open to increase ventilation in classrooms.
- We have cancelled all non-essential meetings and gatherings.
- Increased cleaning of high traffic areas.
- Limiting visitors, volunteers and external providers who come into our school.
- Canteen will be limited to **orders only**, there will be no sales over the counter.



In the interest of public health, please keep your children at home if they are unwell.

Cancellations

In light of the current situation, several school events will be cancelled until further notice.

KIMP Practice Journal Sheets

It was wonderful last week to see so many KIMP students proudly showing Mr Walsh and I their new practice journal sheets. Some students had already made amazing progress in just one week and the best part was to see them recognising the difference in their playing and their happy, proud faces. All KIMP students should have a practice sheet - yellow for Beginners and Intermediate Band, pink for Senior Band students. Please email me if you haven't yet seen a practice sheet. It should be signed each week by parents and then shown to Mr Walsh or myself in lessons. The purpose of these practice journals is to encourage the establishment of a consistent practice routine which then leads to great progress and ongoing enjoyment. Yes it takes effort at home - I totally get it having had my own children learning instruments over the years and continuing to do so now. But it's worth it for so many reasons!

Senior Band students have also been told that if they aren't practicing consistently they will be moved back to Intermediate Band at the end of this term until they are committed enough to put in the effort required for Senior Band. I am hoping they will all stay in Senior Band and have given them 5 weeks on the practice journal to show us their routines.

KIMP Homework Sheets - we are now into Week 3 of our new KIMP 'homework' sheets and I think they are very worthwhile. Please encourage your musician to complete the sheet at home, it just helps us cover and reinforce some of the fundamentals.

KIMP Tutor Books - there are still a number of KIMP beginners who haven't purchased their tutor book from the office (\$22). We are using these books in lessons each week and students need them to practice with at home. Please make sure your child has what they need to practice at home and brings it with them to their lesson each week. It makes a big difference to their progress!

Any questions please email me ... hopefully you're hearing lots of playing at home! Some of our new beginners are going SO well, I am loving my Monday lessons with all of them!

At the moment **all band rehearsals are postponed** until further notice. You could use this time for practicing though!!! What a great idea!!!

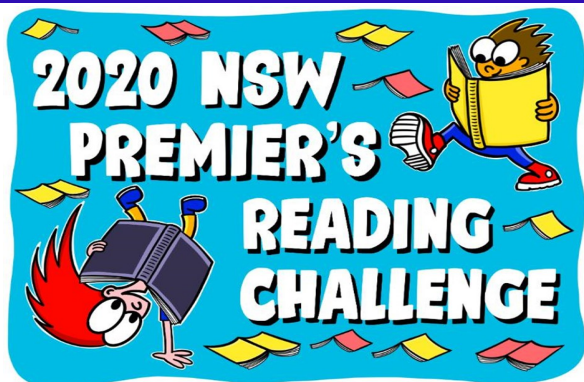
