While we return next week, our staged return to school continues this week, with students allocated to one day per week, learning at school and 4 days at home. Our current alphabetical allocation applies this week.

As stated last week, where possible, please stick to your allocated day, in order to keep numbers low in each class, facilitating social distancing for students and teachers. Please do not send children on other days, unless it is necessary; wanting to see friends is not a compelling reason at the moment.

Please remind your children to bring their home learning to school with them, as well as any school device they may have borrowed.



As bubblers are closed at the moment, a drink bottle is also recommended. Canteen is not open, so bring your own lunches and snacks too.

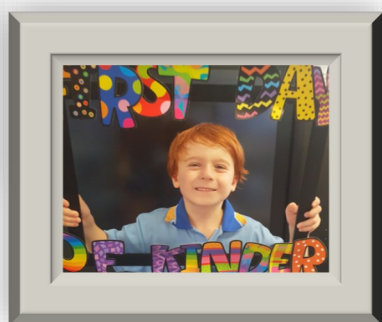
We are now taking enrolments for Kindergarten 2021.

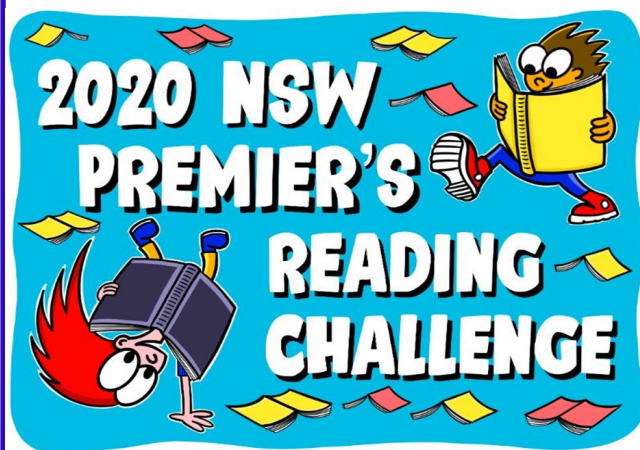
The Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)

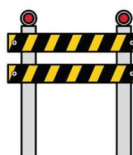
