Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in our lives. At Kingscliff Public School, we recognise that when changes occur in families through death, separation, divorce or related circumstances, young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively. We are therefore offering a very successful education program called Seasons for Growth. This program is facilitated in small groups and is based on research that highlights the importance of social support and the need to practise new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problemsolving, decision-making, effective communication and support networks.

<u>How would this work?</u> Seasons for Growth runs for eight weeks and each weekly session is 40-45 minutes. The program concludes with a 'Celebration' session. If you think your son or daughter would benefit from Seasons for Growth. It is suggested that you discuss this with your child prior to nominating for participation.

Should you wish to proceed to nominate your child, please contact the office in person, via phone or email. You will be asked to complete an expression of interest slip declaring your interest. Steph will contact interested parties early next term.

Kingscliff Public School is pleased to be able to offer this important program and we are confident that it will be a valuable learning experience for those who request to be involved.


The office will send home invoices for Term 3 at the beginning of next term. If you have any outstanding fees from term 1 could you please pay these as a matter of urgency.
