A child was dropped off, across the street from the school and while the parent waited in the car, the child was sent across the street.

There was a row of cars dropping off, in the kiss and drop zone, and a car pulled out to leave, not noticing that a child was crossing between the cars ahead.

Thankfully, they were able to stop, avoiding what could have been an awful situation. PLEASE use the crossing. DO NOT send children across the road, or pick up and take them across, unless you use the crossing. Your child's safety is at the core of this request.

Our school continues to be a focus for road safety, with <u>another visit from police</u> last week. They have assured us that there will be regular visits to ensure congestion is kept to a minimum, and that all drivers adhere to road rules such as not parking in the pickup zone, queuing across the pedestrian crossing or double parking.

Thank you to everyone who is displaying your <u>names on</u> <u>visors or dashboard</u>, on pick up, and moving up the line as space becomes available. The queue is moving more quickly and I'm sure it will continue to improve.

Adults <u>waiting on the footpath</u> are asked to please stand clear of cars in the kiss and drop zone, and to stand off of the road, so that students can get into cars easily and cars can move away. I know it is a crowded space, but if we all work together the congestion eases quickly. Everyone does not have to pick up at 3:01pm. Consider arriving a few minutes later, once some initial congestion eases. Kindy children can then be given some space to find their parents. Thanks for considering your options in this regard.
