Morning arrivals and afternoon pick ups

As you are aware our teachers are on duty from 8:30 each morning. Other than students who have prearranged, scheduled events (eg: band or music lessons) or arriving on the first bus, students should not be at school prior to this. Early arrivals must attend their event or sit under the COLA, to wait for the duty teacher to start.

I have noticed drop offs getting earlier and earlier, with some students here at 8am or earlier. In exceptional circumstances, we can accommodate this if required, but this should be prearranged.

With the hall build progressing well, I remind everyone, that the trades begin work each day at 7am. Deliveries take place where possible before school, with more vehicle movements in the early hours. While there are some staff members on site, students here early are not directly supervised. Please assist us to keep all children safe by arriving at 8:30 or later. Thank you.

Our afternoon pick ups are improving. Thank you all, for getting those signs in your windows and moving the queue forward as soon as you can.
