COOK A HEALTHY TREAT

French Toast with Berries and Pistachios

Ingredients:

- 2 eggs
- Light milk
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4 thick slices wholegrain bread (or 8 small)
- 1 cup raspberries
- 1 cup light vanilla yoghurt
- 1/3 cup roughly chopped unsalted pistachios.

Method

1. Beat eggs and whisk in milk, sugar and vanilla.
2. Soak bread in egg mixture one slice at a time and turn to coat both sides.
3. Heat a non-stick pan over a low-medium heat.
4. Pan fry bread for around 2-3 minutes each side until golden.
5. Serve with a dollop of yoghurt and top with pistachios and berries.
