- ♦ be aware of your surroundings

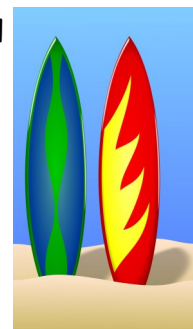

Learning Intention
 I am learning to be **RESPONSIBLE**


Success Criteria


- I can identify where I am meant to go when the bell rings (discuss different bells and locations)
- I can list the important places I need to go in the school (classroom, COLA, library, toilets etc.)
- I can demonstrate what a responsible student looks like when transitioning around the school (moving quietly, walking on hand surfaces, staying in safe areas etc.)

- I know where I have to go when the **bell rings**
