

Schools in the Tweed area have returned under <u>Level 3</u> <u>restrictions</u> and the community will be informed as restrictions ease. This means some activities are still limited:

- no dance or music ensembles, but lessons can continue for KIMP;
- minimising cross cohort mixing, which means classbased activities for most things, with some stage or year group activities;
- no excursions, assemblies or external visitors; drop off and pick up from the gates;
- all adults on site must sign on with QR code and wear masks:
- teachers wear masks at school and there is a recommendation for students to wear them, however this is not mandatory.

Over the next few weeks, it is likely that regional areas could be placed into a 'snap lockdown' if cases arise in the LGA. As a result, we are preparing for this, with some work packages and learning at home information being sent home this week.

Thank you to families for using our <u>coloured gate system</u> for <u>arrivals and departures</u> each day. It is helping to clear congestion on Orient Street and getting students picked up safely. Please remember that supervision begins at 8:30am. Where possible students should arrive after that time.

Schools in our area have just been cleared to hold <u>Kindy Orientation</u>, which is very exciting. We have changed the dates slightly. Students will be able to attend on three occasions from week 4, 5 or 6 so save these date: Oct 28 or 29^{th} ; November 4^{th} or 5^{th} and November 11^{th} and 12^{th} . At this stage parents cannot come to these sessions, however we are planning information sessions after hours, possibly on the Wednesdays of the same weeks. 

At the moment while we are on Level 3 Restrictions we aren't allowed to have band but hopefully that might change as the term goes along ... in the meantime we are very grateful that we can have lessons face to face. My brother in law is an instrumental music teacher and amazing musician in Sydney and the long haul zoom lessons have been really really tough for him and his students ... so we are certainly appreciative of being able to teach at Kingy at the moment.

KIMP Busking!!!!! Band might be off the cards for the time being but we are currently planning our second annual KIMP Busking Festival for this term. We had our first busking festival last year, a positive initiative to come from COVID! This will be an opportunity for every single KIMP student to perform in an informal setting and last year it was a great success and the students all said they enjoyed it.

Practice motivation tips! It has been a hard second half of the year to be learning an instrument and I know that getting kids to practice at home at the moment could be well down your list of things to do, and that's totally understandable. Hopefully having the busking to work towards will help us all with encouraging practice. Just go back to basics - try to get a routine going. If they can practice consistently they will start to sound better, regain their confidence and enjoyment and then feel better about practicing. Remember it doesn't have to be hours of practice, you will get the best results with more days of shorter practices. Just 15 minutes each school day would make a big difference and that will then turn into 20 mins as they improve and start enjoying playing again. Please let me know if your child is needing some help to stay motivated, then I can help them at school.

Some families are not on Facebook so I will keep email as our main form of communication but use Facebook for photos and videos. Please let me know if you aren't receiving my KIMP group emails.
