School Travel for 2022

2022 school travel applications are now open. Students who need a travel pass for 2022 can apply now. A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for a school travel pass for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).



Students who change address, school, campus location, or who have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should renew or update their details before the end of term 4. This will ensure that schools can endorse applications and current entitlements are updated and remain valid.

On 1 October 2021 the School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) information and application portal was moved to **[transportnsw.info](#)**. This will assist families to find all their travel information in the one place.

[Travel from Term 1 2022](#)

We ask that parents plan ahead and make sure their child knows which service/s to use and has a valid pass to use from the start of the school year. Applications for the School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) opened at the start of Term 4 2021 for travel in 2022, so parents/students can apply or update details early and be ready for the start of the new school year.

The start of the year is a difficult period for local bus operators, and students travelling without a valid ticket make service planning and operations increasingly difficult. We recognise that for some families last minute changes to school enrolments mean they may not have a Travel Pass for the start of term.

Bus operators are flexible and understanding, particularly at the start of the school year, and will ensure students can travel safely to and from school. But to best support our operators we encourage all students to have a valid pass, as early as possible, from the start of the school year.





BOOK CHARACTER MUFTI DAY



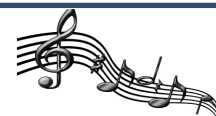
Term 4 Week 6 - Tuesday 9th November

KIMP 2022!

Hard to believe but it's that exciting time of year when we start planning for next year's KIMP program. This Wednesday our Year 2 classes will be treated to the annual KIMP 'Demos' where some of our Senior KIMP students demonstrate their instruments and talk about KIMP. All Year 2 students will be given an Expression of Interest form to take home. If you are interested in your child learning an instrument and being part of KIMP in 2022 you will just need to return the form to school by the date on the letter. I will then do 'try outs' where I assess which instrument/s I think each student is best suited to. The allocation of instruments depends on several factors - ability to manage the instrument eg. big enough to hold it, able to make a sound, availability of instruments for hire at school, which instrument students would like to learn.

Re-Enrolment Forms for existing KIMP students - all existing KIMP students who are continuing next year will need to return a re-enrolment form to the office. I will start handing these out this week. Please return these to the office as soon as possible to allow us to plan for next year.

If you have any questions at all about KIMP please just email me. I am really looking forward to seeing our Year 2 classes and can't wait to welcome them to the KIMP family! It is a wonderful opportunity to join our amazing program here at Kingy and start to gain all the incredible benefits that come from learning an instrument.

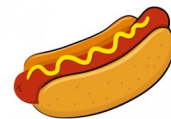
