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PRINCIPAL NEWS



It's week 3 already, what a great start to the term. It has been fantastic having

parents and carers on site too. From week 5 parents and carers will have to drop off and pick up from gates again. This is in line with Department of Education policy.

'Parents and carers for Preschool, Kindergarten and Years 1, 2 and 7 students will be allowed on the school site to drop off their children at their classes on the first few days of schools provided they follow physical distancing and hygiene measures implemented by the school and the department. Parents and carers may also enter the school to pick up students for the first few days based on each school arrangements for these year groups.'

Please remember to check in using the QR codes, which are found on the fence, every time you come in to drop your children off or pick them up.

We have had a few questions from parents/carers about students with mild flu like symptoms. The Department states:

'Students with flu-like symptoms will need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test will not be permitted to return to school for a 10day period. Additionally, they must be symptomfree for at least 3 days prior to returning to school.'

If you do come in to pick up students, we also ask you to pick them up and then exit straight away. Please do not hang and talk to others, or

let your children play on the playground equipment. We have to remain vigilant and as we are still provided with a COVID cleaner during the day, our playground equipment is also wiped throughout the day too.
