## PRINCIPAL NEWS

What a wonderful start we have had to the year, with our kindergarten students settling in very quickly to their morning routines. It has been a treat to see parents for our younger students on site for a few weeks.

Unfortunately, they have now transitioned to being dropped off at the gate. Until further notice, parents and carers can only attend prearranged meetings or go to the office for canteen, payments and other enquiries.

### Parent teacher meetings

Our term 1 parent meetings have been very successful, with much positive feedback from parents and teachers alike. Our goal is to arrange as many scheduled opportunities for parents to attend the school, in a COVID safe manner, so that community engagement can increase this year, in our new COVID safe 'normal'.



Our next event will be our "Leadership Induction Assembly". Parents of our school leaders, stay tuned for specific details about this event.

### Excerpt from DoE guidelines, regarding unwell students and staff

Students and staff must not attend school or work if they are unwell, even with the mildness of symptoms including fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste, and loss of smell. Students need to be symptom free and a negative COVID-19 test result must be received and sighted by the school prior to their return to school.



Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test are not permitted to return to school for 10 days and they must be symptom free for at least 3 days prior to their return.

Students who have seasonal allergic rhinitis or another condition that presents similarly to flu-like symptoms are still required to get tested for COVID-19 and return a negative test result. Where their symptoms continue beyond 10 days, students should provide documentation from their GP confirming their symptoms are typical for their condition.

Isolated incidents of sneezing or coughing may not indicate that a student is suffering from an illness. Staff should talk with students about how they are feeling to determine if a cough/sneeze is an isolated incident or whether the student is unwell. Where a student is unwell arrangements should be made to send them home.

COVID-19 testing for very young students or students with complex health or disability may be challenging. In these situations, schools are to ask the parent/carer to have their child assessed by their medical practitioner. Where a medical practitioner determines that a COVID-19 test is not indicated, a medical certificate must be provided to the school to confirm that the student does not have symptoms that warrant a COVID-19 test. The certificate must also indicate that the student is able to return to the school environment.

### **Bike Safety**

It has been wonderful to see so many students riding their bikes to school again, this year. However, there have been several calls to the school, regarding safety concerns for our students. Students are crossing roads without looking, riding in large groups and not following the road rules, some are riding through the Woolies carparks in between traffic. There have been several distressed community members call us. One last week, almost hit a child, near Woolies, others have had a near miss at Sutherland St and the south end of Orient Street.

I urge all parents to please discuss road safety with any child riding to school. Helmets must be worn and the road rules followed. Riding in large groups is not safe on public roads. Please help to keep Kingy kids safe. Thank you.
