The results of these tests will provide important information to our school about what each student can do and will be used to support teaching and learning programs.

Each year students are usually invited to march on ANZAC day for the Kingscliff RSL march but again due to COVID, it will only be our School Captains and Vice Captains attending. Important changes to pick-up and drop-off zones There are changes coming to parking regulations in the school zone to improve road safety. Buses will be separated from the parent 'pick-up and drop-off' areas and where families cross the road to reduce potential conflicts. All buses are being moved to Sutherland Street and the Orient Street 'pick-up and drop-off' zone will be longer.

From the start of Week 2 (April 26) the five minute parking in Sutherland Street will be removed to accommodate the extra buses using this area. The 'pick-up and drop-off' zone in Orient Street will be extended further to replace the bus zone. The 5 minute parking in Sutherland Street has already been reduced to accommodate more buses, please be mindful of this. Please make sure if you are picking up your child, you have a name plate for the front window of your car as this will speed up the process.


