### <u>Pick up procedures</u>

The school pick up zone is improving, but there are still some hicc-ups. Here is an overview of how the zone is meant to operate. I thank you in advance for supporting the school to make this process as smooth and efficient as possible.

#### School expectations:

- <u>Car pick up only on Orient Street (none on Sutherland)</u>
- Please <u>stay</u> in your car, this is a no stopping zone.
- <u>Move</u> up the queue to close the gaps, as soon as possible.
- Place your <u>name card</u> on the dash or visor. You can make your own card, or ask the office to assist you.
- <u>Roaming teacher</u> (usually Mrs Mirana) will call your child out (we are now using phone speakers).
- Ideally, children enter cars at the top end of the zone.
- Children should <u>enter</u> the car from the <u>CURB side</u>, <u>belts on and leave promptly</u>.
- Please <u>keep moving up</u>, to avoid queuing down the street.
