#### Enrol Now for 2022

Kindergarten

It is the time of year when we are taking enrolments for 2022. If you currently have children at the school, with a kindy student coming next year, please ensure you contact the office for an enrolment pack and complete the process as soon as possible. Transition will be commencing soon, and we don't want to miss anyone!

#### Changes to gates for pick up

As the school build progresses there will be some changes to accessibility to school gates. As of **NEXT week**, the following will be in place:

- Front double gates, Orient Street: Blue gate. This gate is for <u>car pick up only</u>. Cars will progress through the kiss and drop zone. Students walk up to and load at the top of the zone (old bus area). Do not load at the gates please.
- Single gate, near crossing, Orient Street: Green Gate. This gate will be for <u>pedestrian</u> only pick up and exit for <u>bikes</u>.
- Laneway gate, Orient St: Pink gate: The gate is pedestrian only for kindergarten students and their siblings.
- Single gate, Sutherland St: Red gate. This gate is primarily the <u>bus</u> gate, although there is also some <u>pedestrian</u> pick up and <u>bikes</u> exiting here.



If you don't practice, you don't improve, you don't enjoy playing and inevitably say it's boring and you don't want to learn an instrument anymore. Please support your child at home to have a consistent practice routine so it becomes something they do at a set time and day...even when they don't feel like it! I know it takes effort but it's worth it and you are giving your child a great opportunity that can impact their learning and stay with them for life.

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
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
