COVID UPDATES

What a difference a day makes. As you are all aware, Byron Shire and surrounding LGAs are now in a 7 day lockdown. Currently, this does not affect our staff, as coming to work in a school is an essential reason to leave the house.

Students may also come to school as usual, even if they have visited other LGAs, as we are in Level 2 restrictions and not offering learning from home yet, our schools are open and students and staff are expected to attend. Education is deemed a "reasonable excuse" for students to leave home, even under the stay at home orders, if it can't be done at home.

Quote from current restriction: "leave home for education if it is not possible to do it at home"

Of course, we will all be monitoring for any COVID-19 symptoms and act on that accordingly. Parents may choose to keep their child at home, as a precaution, after visiting the other LGAs, but this is a personal decision. KPS is not providing work at home at this time as our current focus is on face-to-face teaching.

There are two ways to know if you have been identified as a close or secondary contact:

1. You get a text or phone call from NSW Health telling you that you are a close contact.
2. You see from the website showing COVID-19 case locations and venues of concern that you have been to a close contact place on the day and time that an infectious person was there. If this happens to you, please call NSW Health on 1800 943 553.

I appreciate the support from the community, reminding students about where they will be picked up each afternoon.

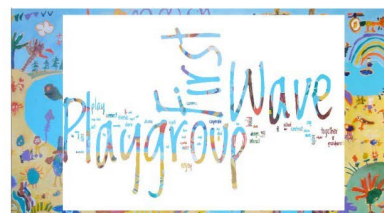
P&C NEWS

Tweed Little Athletics competes each Saturday at 8am and offers registration for Under 6 through to Under 17.

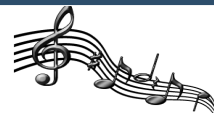
