Road Safety and Awareness

The school is working very hard to create a smooth pick up process at the Orient Street "pick up area". We have been working with the local police as well and ask parents to assist us with the process.

Please remember that this is a **NO STOPPING ZONE**! We ask that any person collecting students by car do the following:

- Place a <u>name card</u> on the dashboard: <u>Large BOLD</u> surname, with first name below. Largest font that will fit on the page please, or use BLACK texta, in BLOCK letters. This process saves time in identifying students. Thank you to those families who already display their names.
- <u>Pull in from the end of the zone</u>, do not cut in front of vehicles. Move through the zone, towards the top, past the school gate.
- Loading the vehicle is in the <u>top half of the zone, past</u> <u>the front gate</u>. Once a line of cars load and leave, the rest move up and load waiting students.
- Students get into cars <u>from curb side</u>. It is not safe to load amidst passing traffic.
- <u>**Teach**</u> your children to do up their **seat belts**. This also saves time and cars can leave quickly.
- Parents are NOT to call students across the road, between waiting cars. We had a near miss last week!
- <u>There is no parking in this zone.</u> If a child does not come in 3 minutes, please leave the zone and re-enter.


