PRINCIPAL NEWS

Road Safety: Thank you for your vigilance with the afternoon pick up routine. Some days are running very smoothly, others a little slow. All the hints below, save time and make pick up seamless, but everyone must play their part. Please remember that this is a **NO STOPPING ZONE**! We ask that any person collecting students by car do the following:



1. Place a **name card** on the dashboard: **Large BOLD** surname, with first name below. Largest font that will fit on the page please, or use BLACK text, in BLOCK letters. This process saves time in identifying students. Thank you to those families who already display their names.

2. Pull in from the end of the zone, do not cut in front of vehicles. Move through the zone, towards the top, past the school gate.
3. **Loading** the vehicle is in the top half of the zone, past the front gate. Once a line of cars load and leave, the rest move up and load waiting students.
4. Students get into cars **from curb side**. It is not safe to load amidst passing traffic.
5. **Teach** your children to do up their **seat belts**. This also saves time and cars can leave quickly.
6. **Parents are NOT to call students across the road, between waiting cars**. We had a near miss last week!
7. **There is no parking in this zone**. If a child does not come in 3 minutes, please leave the zone and re-enter.
8. **Consider when you come to school**. Everyone does not have to arrive right at 3pm. Wait a few minutes, your children will still be waiting.
9. Pedestrian pick up, please use the gate near the pedestrian crossing.

Coastal Academy - STEM Excellence Challenge

Last Friday Miss Smith along with Maia, Eve, Indi and Willow (who were the STEM arcade challenge winners) joined students from Bogangar and Kingscliff High to travel to SCU Lismore. We were given a private tour of the University lead by 3 different doctors of their field. The day started with learning about the impact of friction on objects and we got to experiment the Universities water tunnel. We then went to the chemistry section where we learnt about how to test the components of aromatherapy oils and how the University is trying to bring species of black rice into Australia. Lastly we were given a lesson by Dr Renaud Joannes-Boyau in the Geoscience centre who taught us how they can determine the diet and lifestyle of people hundreds of years ago by studying their teeth. It was a great day put on by SCU and the Coastal Academy of STEM Excellence project.

Veggie Pasta Pancakes

Ingredients
100 grams angel hair pasta
1 cob fresh corn, kernels cut off
1 310 gram tin creamed corn
1 cup sliced mushrooms
3 spring onions, sliced
1 red capsicum, diced
6 eggs
Oil for cooking

Method
Cook pasta according to packet directions, drain and run the knife through to chop up pieces.
Mix all the ingredients together in a bowl.
Spoon tablespoons of mixture and cook for 3-5 minutes on each side in a lightly oiled frying pan or on a bbq plate until each side is browned.
