PRINCIPAL NEWS

What a start to the year! While it has been unusual, it has been lovely to see our students and parents again. Classes have settled into their routines quickly and are adjusting to new schedules. We are having 2 **lunch and recess breaks** this year, to accommodate the smaller playground. This gives students more space to play, with less congestion outside.

Teachers have been advised to **wear masks** where possible. The masks can be removed when giving direct instruction to the class, for clarity and understanding and to support the learning needs of all students. Masks are then returned for classroom circulation and small group work. Exceptions are made for students with learning difficulties or hearing issues. Student masks are recommended but not mandatory. Child size masks are available at the office.

Thank you all for supporting our **staggered exit** during these first few weeks of school. It is working quite smoothly as each group leaves the school. This will continue for the next 2 weeks at least.

It is now time to collect your **RAT kits** for the next 2 weeks. They will be available for the office window this week. While collection by an adult is our preferred option, we have had confirmation that we can send the kits home with students, with parental permission. Please contact the office if you cannot collect in person and would like the kits sent home with your child. Please ensure you get them from your child's bag as soon as possible.

We have been fielding questions about **household contacts**. I have copied this extract from the NSW government website, for your information.

If you are a household contact:

- You must follow the <u>Self-isolation guideline</u> and self-isolate for 7 days from the time the first COVID-positive person in your household had their test.
- Have a rapid antigen test (RAT) as soon as possible and again on Day 6. Have an additional RAT if you develop symptoms.
- If all tests are negative, you can leave isolation after 7 days.
- If you get a positive result, you should continue your isolation and follow the <u>Testing positive to COVID-19</u> and managing COVID-19 safely at home advice.
- Do not visit high-risk settings (healthcare, aged care, disability care, correctional facilities) for the next 7 days after leaving isolation.
- If another member of your household tests positive while you are in isolation, you do not have to restart your isolation period.
- If you are a household close contact who is unable to separate from the COVID-19 positive person, you should self-isolate with them until they are released from isolation.

As we move into the year, various school activities are restarting, the first of which is our **swimming carnival** on Friday. Due to restrictions, unfortunately we are only taking our competent swimmers 8 years and older. Spectators are also not permitted and students will be sitting in year groups, rather than house groups. Hopefully, the weather gods will be kind to us on Friday.

We look forward to resuming more events and connecting with you all, throughout 2022.
