Although we have the limited spaces outside, well-resourced classrooms are filled with eager students and passionate and dedicated teachers, building knowledge and a love for learning. Schools require resources. In response to some questions about our school contributions and textbook fees, here is an overview of what they are and how they are used.

Voluntary school contributions are one source of income that public schools use to purchase resources for their school. These were once called school fees and the fees or contribution are used to buy many consumable items that students use each day. From online subscriptions to exercise books, art supplies to mini white boards, the list is endless. Contributions become part of our budget. Estimates of our yearly contributions, are added to school funds to buy resources in advance, ready for student use.

Similarly, most students will use a textbook at some time. The texts are purchased in advanced, ready for use each year. Families are requested to purchase these books for their child's use. Ideally, everyone would be able to contribute. However, if your family is not in the position to do so, not to worry, no student will miss out.

Voluntary contributions and textbook notices will be sent out this term. Thank you in advance to all of you who have already paid.

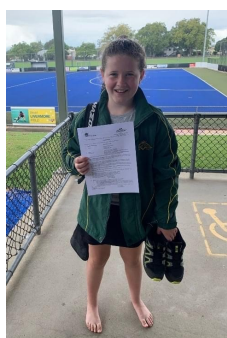
Cross Country

Trivia Night

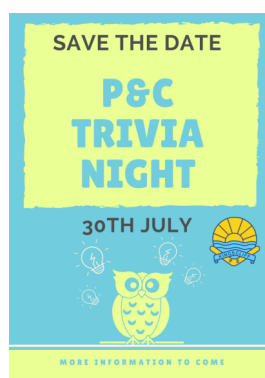
