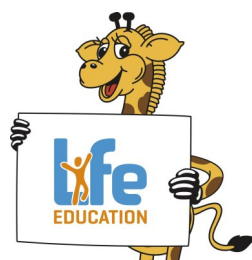
All students arriving after 9am are required to be signed in by their parent/carer at the school office to avoid a text message sent home.

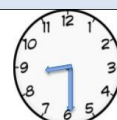

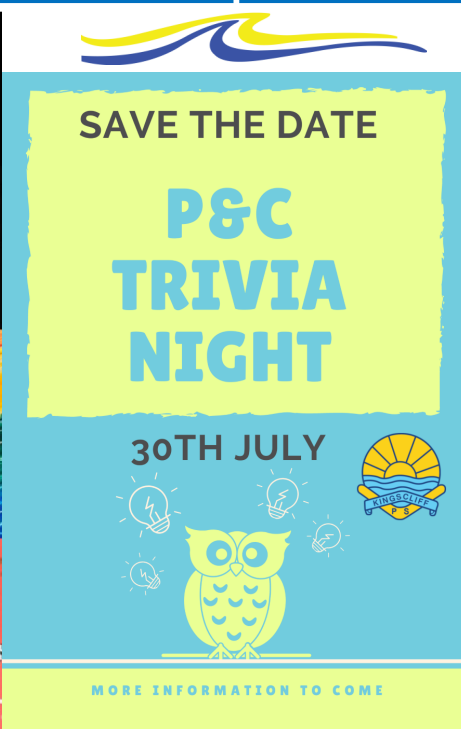
