This week we had a huge shipment of new RAT tests delivered to the school, so if you need some, please see our office for some more. Stay home if unwell \cdot

Your child should only return to school once they have returned a negative test and they are symptom free.

If your child tests positive to COVID-19, register the positive result with Service NSW, isolate for 7 days. Students are not to return to school, even if they test negative, in those 7 days and follow NSW health guidelines
