Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

Kingscliff Public School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities to cater for enrolment growth in the area. The scope of work includes replacement of all classrooms including demountable buildings, a new library, an extended hall with new canteen, new outdoor spaces and a redeveloped school entry.

Progress summary

The State Significant Development Application (SSDA) for the project has now been lodged with the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE).

As part of the pre-lodgement process, some changes were made to the design of the upgrade to deliver better outcomes for the school and local residents (see overleaf).

A Review of Environmental Factors has been completed to enable construction of new administration facilities (Building 2) to commence while the SSDA for the remainder of the upgrade is being assessed by DPIE.

Establishment of the site compound and construction area for Building 2 will take place in the mid-year school holidays. More details about associated works will be shared with the community at that time.



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
Update to Buildings 3 & 4

As part of the SSDA pre-lodgement process some changes were made to the design of the upgrade to deliver better outcomes for the school and local residents. A number of learning spaces originally planned to be located in Building 4, will now be located in Building 3.

This change was made in consultation with the school and will offer good integration of these learning spaces with other functions located in and around the centre of the upgraded school layout. The change has also reduced the height and size of the southern end of Building 4, which will reduce the potential impact of the building on local residents.
